## Careerpilot user guide for a new career leader

#### Do you have an admin password set up to access Careerpilot yet?

You will need an admin password to log in to Careerpilot to access:

- careers resources for every year group in the Adviser Zone;
- data and reports on the choices students are making in the Reporting Zone;
- the Pathway Planner tools and reports (if your school is set up to access this).

### Support more students to register on Careerpilot

Students can register for their own FREE account on Careerpilot and save their choices and quiz results to their Career Tools, which you can view in the Reporting Zone. They can use Careerpilot in school (download Careerpilot lesson resources from the Adviser Zone to help you deliver) or they can access Careerpilot independently, on their phone or online device at home. Its easy to register:

Students register themselves, they click on 'register' in the top right-hand corner of the home page or visit careerpilot.org.uk/register




They need to complete the short registration form

Student registration

Students need to enter their name, date of birth and home postcode.

They will need to make up their own password—we recommend choosing one that they are least likely to forget or make a note of it somewhere!

Students need to select their year group. This automatically moves up on the system each year on August 31st.




They can use either their school email address or a personal email address—we suggest they use the one that they use most often.

Then can then choose their school or college from the drop down list.

Finally, they will need to type in the Captcha Code (this is to make sure that they are human!).

\*They must tick the box to say that they have read the Ts and Cs to complete registration

Students can then log in to explore their strengths, understand their options and inspire their future career. And you can view their choices in the Reporting Zone.



### Careerpilot as part of your whole-school career provision

Careerpilot can be used as part of a stable careers plan across your whole school or college. Careerpilot puts the students at the centre of the career programme and provides activities and resources to support effective careers provision for 11-19 year olds, with support for the careers leader, career advisers and teaching staff. The information students build in their Career Tools reports helps staff and career advisers find out more about what their students are interested in, meeting individual needs.
