


Careerpilot 10 reasons why....

<h2>1</h2>	<p>Careerpilot is an award winning, 11-19, student focused site that helps young people develop the skills to be career-ready, so they can manage their future careers and helps schools and colleges develop a stable careers programme.</p>	
<h2>2</h2>	<p>Careerpilot has a dedicated <u>Parent Zone</u> answering some of the key questions parents want to ask, so they can support their child</p>	
<h2>3</h2>	<p>Careerpilot has an <u>Adviser Zone</u> with lots of resources to help a school build a stable careers programme e.g. activities for every year group, 5 week PSHE sessions, tutor time activities, etc. Some resources are in the Members' Area and require a login to the admin area.</p>	
<h2>4</h2>	<p>Careerpilot has a <u>Reporting Zone</u> where you can see the choices your students are interested in and add your adviser/tutor reports and actions. You can use the data to plan encounters. Students can add encounters to the Skills Profile.</p>	
<h2>5</h2>	<p>Careerpilot will help you meet the Gatsby Benchmarks and through our <u>Career Leader Portal</u> we have maps to show you how. And, also, how you can use it when you are completing Compass and a new guide which show you how to embed CP in your whole school programme to meet Gatsby.</p>	
<h2>6</h2>	<p>Careerpilot has the <u>Pathway Planner</u>, which can be purchased as an add-on. The Pathway Planner is a triage tool and model developed and piloted with funding from the Careers and Enterprise company—which allocates guidance according to student need—it helps meet G8 and G3.</p>	
<h2>7</h2>	<p>Careerpilot offers <u>free training and support</u> to help you implement the web tools in your context.</p>	
<h2>8</h2>	<p>Careerpilot is designed and developed by careers adviser, ex-teachers and career leaders—we are passionate about careers and helping young people progress.</p>	
<h2>9</h2>	<p>Careerpilot develops professional careers practice by offering the <u>Level 6 Diploma in Careers Guidance</u> and providing free <u>Career Guides</u> for popular and changing pathways</p>
